

Award “Centenario dell’Acquedotto Pugliese”



Partecipazione: Om and SWL from Italy and outside Italy.

Period: Starts from 00:00 UTC on April 24th and ends at 24:00 UTC on April 26th.

Bands: 20 and 40 meter.

Modes: SSB, CW, RTTY/PSK.

Note: Will be active, only on Sunday April 26th, 5 portable stations from important locations of the AQP (Apulian Water Service).

These locations are:

- 1) Sorgenti Sanità di Caposele (Av) ref. AQP 01**
- 2) Parco del Marchese (Ta) ref. AQP 02**
- 3) Diga di Camastra (Pz) ref. AQP 03**
- 4) Diga del Fortore Masseria Finocchito (FG) ref. AQP 04**
- 5) Scarico terminale AQP Santa Maria di Leuca (Le) ref. AQP 05**

QSO mode:

1) Italian Stations: Italian stations must work special station I17AQP that will be active from April 24th to April 26th and at least 4 over 5 portable stations that will be active on Sunday April 26th.

2) Foreign stations: Foreign stations must work the special station I17AQP that will be active from April 24th to April 26th and at least 3 over 5 portable stations that will be active on Sunday April 26th.

Exchanges: Every portable station valid for the award will exchange RS(T) plus the AQP reference of that station. QSO-time reference is not necessary. The special station I17AQP will only exchange RS(T).

How to require the award: The award "Centenario dell'Acquedotto Pugliese" will be sent as PDF file to all those who require it by the following modalities. There will be no paper printed award sent by postal service. To require the Award it will be necessary to apply on the specific module on the Sezione ARI di Bari web page (URL <http://www.ari-bari.it/diplomaAQP/>).

All the requests will be managed by our QSL Manager in a few days time and the award will be sent by e-mail. In the application module it will be possible to require the paper QSL via the Bureau of all the single special stations worked. All those who would like to receive the paper QSL(s) (even if they haven't reached the number of worked stations for the award) can apply at <http://www.aribari.it/qs/AQP/> .
